
1966 - December 3 - 2016 **GOLDEN JUBILEE - Ordination to the Priesthood**


Dear Bishop,

BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR DECEMBER 2016

Third December is a memorable day in my life. I will be celebrating 50 years as a priest. Please join me in thanking the Lord for the gift of priesthood and 50 years of priestly ministry. As a priest, I spent my entire life for the Diocese of Mangalore in your company serving the people of God in this Diocese. I have all joys in my life while recounting the years that I have spent. I thank you sincerely for your love, concern and cooperation during these 50 years. I will offer the thanksgiving mass at the Cathedral on 3 December 2016 at 9.30 a.m. Kindly join me for concelebration to thank the Lord.

On the 3 December we celebrate the feast of St Francis Xavier, the Patron of the missions and missionaries. Let us pray to the great Saint to pray for us in a special manner in our missionary venture in *Same*, Africa.

The year 2017 is dedicated to Small Christian Communities in Mangalore Diocese. The inauguration of the year will take place on 8 January 2017. SAINT NICHOLAS (SANTA CLAUS) AND CHRISTMAS

There are many symbols associated with Christmas e.g. Christmas Tree, Christmas Star, Santa Claus etc. These symbols remind us of the season of Christmas.

Saint Nicholas was a Bishop who lived in the fourth century was known for helping the poor. His feast is celebrated on 6th December. Over a period of time Saint Nicholas has become Santa Claus. Many a time, he is wrongly portrayed and seen as an object of fun and entertainment. Season of Advent is a time to restore the relevance of this symbol and make use of it to create a mood of Christmas around us. This idea was discussed in the Diocesan Pastoral Parishad held on 24-11-2016 and it was accepted to hold a rally of Santa Claus on Saturday 17 December 2016.

The Episcopal and City deaneries will hold a rally on 17th after-noon. All those who have two wheelers from these two deaneries are expected to participate in the rally. Four wheelers are welcome to join the rally. Those who participate in the rally will wear only a red Santa Claus cap and not the rest of it to avoid wrong portrayal. A decorated float depicting the Christmas event will be brought in procession to the assembling place. At the assembling place Christmas carols willbe sung followed by a Christmas message by the Bishop. SUMMARY OF NEW VATICAN GUIDELINES FOR BURIAL AND CREMATION

On October 25, 2016, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith issued a document entitled Ad resurgendum cum Christo (To Rise with Christ) "regarding the burial of the deceased and the conservation of the ashes in the case of cremation." The document has become necessary as cremation is increasingly used around the world, along with a rise in beliefs and practices that are contrary to Catholic doctrine on death, burial, and the afterlife.

Nothing has changed in Church teaching, rather, this document is a restatement of previous guidelines due to the wide spread mishandling of cremated remains. The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith has deemed opportune the publication of a new Instruction, with the intention of:

- (1) Underlining the doctrinal and pastoral reasons for the preference of the burial of the remains of the faithful, and
- (2) To set out norms pertaining to the conservation of ashes in the case of cremation.

Summary of Document

- Following the most ancient Christian tradition, the Church insistently recommends that the bodies of the deceased be buried in cemeteries or other sacred places.
- Burial is above all the most fitting way to express faith and hope in the resurrection of the body.
- By burying the bodies of the faithful, the Church confirms her faith in the resurrection of the body, and intends to show the great dignity of the human body.
- Burial in a cemetery or another sacred place adequately corresponds to the piety and respect owed to the bodies of the faithful departed who through Baptish have become temples of the Holy Spirit.

- The burial of the faithful departed in cemeteries or other sacred places encourages family members and the whole Christian community to pray for and remember the dead.
- Through the practice of burying the dead in cemeteries, in churches or their environs, Christian tradition has upheld the relationship between the living and the dead and has opposed any tendency to minimize, or relegate to the purely private sphere, the event of death and the meaning it has for Christians.
- In circumstances when cremation is chosen because of sanitary, economic or social considerations, this choice must never violate the explicitly-stated or the reasonably inferable wishes of the deceased faithful.
- The Church raises no doctrinal objections to this practice, since cremation of the deceased's body does not affect his or her soul.
- Thus cremation, in and of itself, objectively negates neither the Christian doctrine of the soul's immortality nor that of the resurrection of the body.
- The Church continues to prefer the practice of burying the bodies of the deceased, because this shows a greater esteem towards the deceased.
- Cremation is not opposed per se to the Christian religion under the condition that his choice has not been made through "a denial of Christian dogmas, the animosity of a secret society, or hatred of the Catholic religion and the Church".
- In the absence of motives contrary to Christian doctrine, the Church, after the celebration of the funeral rite, accompanies the choice of cremation, providing the relevant liturgical and pastoral directives.
- When, for legitimate motives, cremation of the body has been chosen, the ashes of the faithful must be laid to rest in a sacred place, that is, in a cemetery or, incertain cases, in a church or an area, which has been set aside for this purpose, and so dedicated by the competent ecclesial authority.

- From the earliest times, Christians have desired that the faithful departed become the objects of the Christian community's prayers and remembrance.
- The reservation of the ashes of the departed in a sacred place ensures that they are not excluded from the prayers and remembrance of their family or the Christian community.
- The conservation of the ashes of the departed in a domestic residence is not permitted.
- It is not permitted to scatter the ashes of the faithful departed in the air, on land, at sea or in some other way, nor may they be preserved in mementos, pieces of jewellery or other objects.
- When a deceased notoriously has requested cremation and the scattering of their ashes for reasons contrary to the Christian faith, a Christian funeral must be denied to that person according to the norms of the law.

1	Be an Animator of the liturgy in all you do. Direct the entire service while leaving to other ministers their proper roles. One and the same Priest must always exercise the presidetial function in all its parts (<i>GIRM</i> 108)	The Priest is not merely to "say" Mass! He does not delegate his role as Presider at any point of the Celebration (GIRM 108; 250)
2	One and the same Priest must always exercise the presidential function in all of its parts. (<i>GIRM</i> 108, 250)	Do not change the Presider's role by saying bless "us" rather than bless "you".
3	Prepare the physical implements of the liturgy including the Lectionary, Missal, Vestments and vessels, etc., delegating sacristans to attend to these and other liturgical details. Prepare a Check-list for the sacristans.	Do not go unprepared (to be continued)

MISERECORDIA ET MISERA

(Mercy and Misery)

by Pope Francis

10 Key Points

1. Mercy Meets Misery

It is an expression of St. Augustine who refers to the incident of Jesus saving a woman taken in adultery from the threat of stoning by religious authorities. "The two of them alone remained: mercy with misery" (1). This teaching is also to point out the path that we are called to follow in the future.

2. Mercy does not end.

The Year of Mercy is over. But, mercy continues. The doors of mercy are closed. But, the doors of our hearts should not be closed (16).

3. Celebrate Mercy

The Church should continue to celebrate mercy through the sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick (5).

4. Benefits Extended

The faithful can validly and licitly receive the sacramental absolution of their sins by the priests of the Priestly Fraternity of Saint Pius X (12). Celebrating 24 hours for the Lord close to the fourth Sunday of Lent encourages fervent experience of the sacrament of confession (11). Priests can continue to absolve sins of abortion (12). The extraordinary ministry of the Missionaries of Mercy continues until further notice (9)

5. New Ventures

The Thirty Third Sunday in Ordinary time will be celebrated as The World Day of the Poor. This would be the worthiest way to prepare for the celebration of the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, who identified with the little ones and the poor and who will judge us on our works of mercy (21). Every Christian community has to dedicate one Sunday in the year to the Word of God. This is to promote among the faithful riches of the Word of God by way of creative catechesis and lectio divina (7).

6. Promote Works of Mercy

Mercy impels us to roll up our sleeves and set about restoring dignity to millions of people; they are our brothers and sisters who, with us, are called to build a "city which is reliable" (18). Among them, clothing the naked is something God did first and God wanted in His life to restore dignity (19).

7. Homily as the Word of Mercy

The priest has to take great care in preparing homily with his experience of mercy to thrill the hearts of the believers before the grandeur of mercy (6)

8. An Inclusive Church

Francis demands priests a careful, profound and far-sighted spiritual discernment, so that everyone, none excluded, can feel accepted by God, participate actively in the life of the community and be part of that People of God which journeys tirelessly towards the fullness of his kingdom of justice, love, forgiveness and mercy (14).

9. Mercy is a Verb.

Francis warns about the temptation to theorise about mercy. We cannot forget the poor (20). The social character of mercy demands that we not simply stand by and do nothing. It requires us to banish indifference and hypocrisy, lest our plans and projects remain a dead letter (19).

10. Best Quote of M&M

"I am loved, therefore I exist; I am forgiven, therefore I am reborn; I have been shown mercy, therefore I have become a vessel of mercy (16)."
